

## Irving Bard

Per David Stearns 28 Apr 2011 -- "Irving Bard is the son of Dr. Richard Bard and Mary Scheury of Boulder, Colorado." "He worked as a waiter and dishwasher in Denver." "According to the Bard family Bible, "Irvin Bard was born Dec 9th A.D. 1848 Sunday". There is no other mention of him in the Collie family collection of Bard memorabilia at the U.C. Boulder Library. In 1870, Erwin is listed as head of household and living with his parents and sister Mary. He is working as a laborer. In 1880 he is a boarder living in Boulder and working as a waiter. He cannot be found in 1900. In 1910 he is living on Market street in Denver and working as a dishwasher in a restaurant. In 1920 he is living alone at 1446 12th Street in Denver. He has no occupation. He is listed as a widower. Attempts to find out who he might have married have been negative. He died within a month or two of the 1920 census."
